Note: Run order may be changed at the discretion of the judges.

Saturday Run Order: Novice Test 1, followed by Novice Test 2 back-to-back. (Handlers do Test 1, then Test 2 and are done).

Intermediate will begin after both Novice Tests and will run Trial 1 followed by Trial 2 back-to-back. (Handlers do Test 1, then Test 2 and are done).

Sunday Run Order: Advanced Trial 1, followed by Advanced Trial 2 back-to-back.

Retriever will start after both Advanced trials and will run Trial 1 followed by Trial 2 back-to back. (Handlers do Test 1, then test 2 and are done).

Move-Ups to the next higher level WILL be offered between tests. Thirty minutes' notice is required.

DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs SIX (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete.

Condition of the Dog. Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the opinion of the judge, they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the Fetch test. Dogs with bandages, sutures, or visible wounds are not eligible. Deaf dogs are allowed to enter so long as the handler is in control of the dog at all times, the dog can complete the requirements of the test, and the dog does not appear to be under undue stress in the opinion of the judge.

PRE-ENTRY FEES

Novice & Intermediate pre-entry fees are \$25/per entry
Advanced & Retriever pre-entry fees are \$35/per entry

WAIT LIST INFORMATION

Tri-State Kennel Club, Inc. is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's pre-entry closing date/time. A maximum of **5 entries per day** will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including waitlisted entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to **4/18/25, at Noon**. No entries may be withdrawn with a refund after closing on 4/18/25, at Noon. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a waitlisted entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait-listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial will receive a full refund.

SIGN-IN and CRATING Areas

There will be a secretary table for check-ins and information.

Dogs will be crated out of view of the Fetch test area, or far enough away as to not cause a distraction to the dog being tested. Limited crating is available in our climate-controlled building on a first-come, first-served basis. If using wire crates, please put a blanket/mat under them when on our blue mats. The building will open at 7 a.m. each day.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund by the Event Committee or any official thereof.

Collars, Leashes, and Harnesses. Dogs must wear a collar. Dogs may wear slip collars, buckle collars, and Martingales in the AKC Fetch test. They may not wear prong collars, e-collars, head collars, muzzles, or body harnesses. Leashes should be 4 ft. to 6 ft. long and should be made of fabric, leather, or biothane.

Novice & Intermediate testing: Please make sure you read the rules and have the appropriate item you are throwing.

Advanced & Retriever testing: Please read the rules and have the appropriate item to throw. We ask that you bring enough of the items you are throwing so that the steward does not have to run back and forth to the start line each time to give it to you. This will keep the tests moving. It is also helpful to have something to put your thrown items in behind you after each retrieve.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. Dogs pulled after closing because of injury or other medical condition are not eligible for a refund. **Bitches in season** will be refunded the full entry fee. Notification in writing must be given to the trial secretary no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial.

TESTING AREA:

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the test area when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility to provide service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the building or test area when required.

EXHIBITOR CHECK-IN: Check-in will be 7:00-7:30 A.M. each day.
Exhibitors MUST check-in EACH day and trial they are entered.

Claims will be arbitrated as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to ensure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations including rabies.

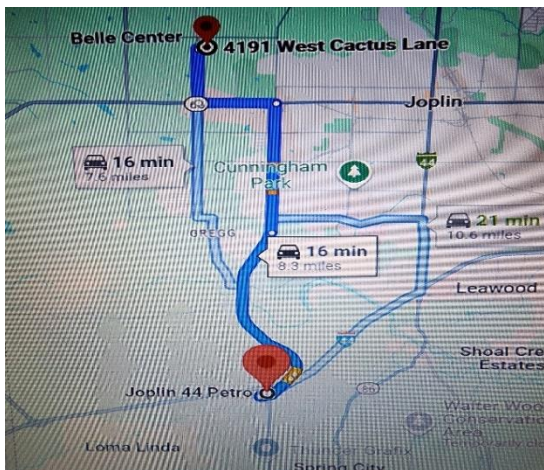

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim of loss, injury or damage to this dog.
